The BEC Summer School is a one week training camp. It is a combination of a training camp for talented junior players and a coach education course open to all European nations. The event is run by Badminton Europe, in cooperation with carefully selected high profile staff coaches.

Coach Education - Level 2 Course

For the first time Badminton Europe will organise a BWF Level 2 Coach Education course as part of BEC Summer School. This course will be based on the BWF Coach Level 2 material. Candidates who successfully pass the course will become certificated BWF Level 2 Coaches. Only Coaches who are certificated BWF Level 1 coaches can enter this course.

Nominations

Every Member Association is invited to nominate up to **6 players** and **4 coaches to take part in the 2015 BEC Summer School**.

For nominated players and coaches it is important that they are ranked in order of preference in case of limited amount of players and coaches per country can be accepted. To have a balanced participation Badminton Europe would welcome any nominations with equal numbers of female and male players and coaches.

Please keep in mind that there is a limited space at the BEC Summer School. In recent years we have experienced massive interest from Member Associations in nominating participants. Therefore it is possible that the number of nominations exceeds the number of available places. That means that nominating a participant does not guarantee entry.

We want to ensure your players and your coaches to benefit as much as possible from our staff coaches and their training programme, therefore badminton courts should not become overcrowded.

For nominations please use the Nomination Forms (Players/Coaches). The closing date for submission is 6 March 2015. Badminton Europe is expected to confirm accepted participants by the end of April 2015.
