Application for the 2017 BEC Regional Projects

Dear Member Association,

In 2016 Badminton Europe approved 10 regional projects all around Europe, which you can follow on our official <u>Development website</u>.

Badminton Europe would like to invite you to apply for the 2017 BEC Regional Project funding.

The aim of the BEC Regional Projects is:

- Encouraging MA's to collaborate together.
- Form a development initiative to enhance and raise the level of badminton in the different regions.
- Knowledge exchange.
- Create and establish long term training programmes/collaborations.

Activities

The project should be a collaboration of a minimum of 3 MA's from the same region, organised as one of the below listed activities:

Training Camps for U13, U15, U17 and/or U19 players



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For the 2017 BEC Regional Projects applications it is essential that collaborating MA's confirm their agreement on collaboration at the time of applying. Badminton Europe is keen to ensure that cooperation between Member Associations take place at all stages of planning through to implementation of the activity.

It is essential that ALL cooperating Member Associations confirm their participation when submitting the project application form to Badminton Europe!

Planning

Proposals should include the **main purpose** and **objective** of the 2017 BEC Regional Project, clearly detailing the **goals** of what the activity is intended to achieve. A good proposal will also include a strategy on how the goals and objectives will be met and indicate a timeline for when they are planned to be achieved.

Projects should have a project leader or organiser. This person should be appointed by the Member Association.

2017 Project Funding

Badminton Europe will consider all proposals and applications and decide which Regional Projects are the most suitable to be supported in 2017. The decision will be made based on the relevance and short and long-term objectives of the proposed projects.

The budget for the 2017 BEC Regional project support is 30 000 EUR + shuttles. In 2017 Badminton Europe will support **up to 10 projects**, by allocating a support of up to **3000 EUR + shuttles** per project.

Badminton Europe funding will be allocated on a **participation basis**. The financial grant will be paid directly to Member Associations. Payment will be made after submitting the requested documentation after completion of the activity. Should all cooperating Member Associations prefer the financial grant to be paid directly to the organising association, please clearly state this in the application.



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The timescale for the procedure

13 September 2016 - Distribution of invitation

10 October 2016 - Closing date for applications

31 October 2016 - Decision on the funding allocation – the information letter to be send to the MA's

Submission of the Application

Please submit Regional Project applications using the Proposal Form attached to this letter, and return it to Zsofia Horvath, BEC Junior Manager to the following address: zsofia.horvath@badmintoneurope.com.

The submission deadline is **Monday**, 10 October 2016.
